Agriculture is increasingly becoming an important driver of the Nigerian economy. It accounts for 26% of GDP and employs 42% of the population.

In recent years, the Nigerian government has placed greater emphasis on the agricultural sector in its efforts to generate broad-based growth, diversify the economy away from oil, create jobs, and achieve food security. The aim is to achieve food security, replace imports, create jobs, and diversify the economy.
